Age: 46 years old	Reason for Scar: Hysterectomy
Initials: CV	Type of Scar: Hypertrophic
Sex: Female	Position of Scar: Abdomen

Previous treatments: Over the years, various topical formulations with no visible results.

Clinical Results:

Patient Evaluation:

Color: 80% improvement throughout the scar

Pain: The scar was not painful so no change in pain level.

Itching: All itching sensations have disappeared.

Hardness: The scar was very soft and thin in certain areas, which have now become firmer and more resistant.

Elevation: No changes in elevation as the scar was mostly flat.

Clinical Case Study

Quality of Life Questionnaire:

Changes in Quality of Life: Much more confident and secure in life.

Itchy, sore, painful or stinging: Slight itching prior to the treatment, which is no longer present. Treatment itself did not give any pain or itching.

Embarrassed or self-conscious: My self esteem is back and my confidence is much higher.

Going shopping or looking after your home or garden: No change.

Influenced the clothes you wear: I am now able to wear much more sexy clothes without being selfconscious.

Social or leisure activities, to do any sport: My scar did not interfere with any social activities, so no changes there.

Prevented you from working or studying: My scar did not interfere with any work or study activities.

Been a problem at work or studying: None

Problems with your partner or any of your close friends or relatives? Since my treatment, I am much more confident with my partner as my scar is less visible and smoother to touch.
